Reciprocal Visitors Policy during Covid

Effective July 24, 2020 – Macassa Bay Yacht Club (MBYC) will begin allowing reciprocal visitors based on availability and the following policies:

- Reciprocal privileges will be offered to members from clubs that are also currently offering visiting privileges to our members
- Up to two nights as per MBYC Reciprocal Policy
- Based on availability and needs to be prearranged

Prior to coming to MBYC:

- Visiting boats need to prearrange their slip assignment (minimum 24 hours' notice) by emailing visiting@mbyc-hamilton.org
- Self-assess – please do not visit MBYC if you:
 - Are feeling unwell or have any symptoms of Covid-19
 - Have tested positive for Covid-19 and have not been moved to recovered status
 - Have travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days
 - Have had contact with anyone with Covid-19 within the last 14 days
 - Have been told by Public Health to self isolate/quarantine

Once at MBYC

- Proceed to assigned slip – 30 amp hydro power is available, water is available on docks
- Check-in at the moment will be with the Officer of the Day or designate at Work Shop Shed (located in middle of parking lot)
- Visitors need to follow provincial rules pertaining to physical distancing and social gathering sizes
- Clubhouse is closed (no bar patio available at moment)
- Washroom access is available – masks are to be worn inside any building as per Hamilton By-Law
- Shower access is available but guests are requested to clean up after themselves
- Visitors must sign Macassa Bay Yacht Club Visitor Waiver relating to Covid-19
