Reciprocal Visitors Policy during Covid

Macassa Bay Yacht Club (MBYC) will begin allowing reciprocal visitors based on availability, depth and the following policies:

- MBYC will only be accepting vessels from reciprocal clubs that are currently open to accepting reciprocal club visitors in return
- One free night; Additional nights at \$25 plus hst per night as per MBYC Reciprocal Policy
- Based on availability and needs to be prearranged

Prior to coming to MBYC:

- Visiting boats need to prearrange their slip assignment preferably at least 24-48 hours in advance by emailing visiting@mbyc-hamilton.org
- Self-assess – please do not visit MBYC if you:
 - Are feeling unwell or have any symptoms of Covid-19
 - Have tested positive for Covid-19
 - Have had contact with anyone with Covid-19 within the last 5 days

Once at MBYC

- Proceed to assigned slip – 30 amp hydro power is available, water is available on docks
- If you haven't been assigned a slip proceed to the pump-out dock
- Check-in will be at upstairs bar in the Clubhouse (Thursdays to Sundays during afternoon) or with Dock Manager/designate
- Visitors must follow provincial and municipal rules pertaining Covid. Masks are recommended but not required. Physical distance where appropriate.
- Clubhouse is open (Thursdays to Sundays during afternoon)
- Shower access is available but guests are requested to clean up after themselves
- Visitors must complete and sign Macassa Bay Yacht Club Visitor Registration Form and Waiver including Covid Safety Check. You can download this form from the [Visitors Guide](#) on our web site. Please complete this in advance of your visit
- Visitors must confirm boat liability insurance and agree not to leave vessel unattended for a period greater than eight (8) hours unless other arrangements have been made
