Reciprocal Policy of Macassa Bay Yacht Club

As a Reciprocal visitor, you will be welcome to two free nights with additional nights at \$25.00 per night plus hst based on availability. Visitor slips are limited to the number of our members away cruising. Deep-water slips are at a great premium. Visiting boats need to prearrange their slip assignment at least 24-48 hours in advance by emailing visiting@mbyc-hamilton.org 24-48 hours.

Amenities available:

- 30A power and water hook ups
- Barbeques, picnic tables
- Clean modern washrooms with showers
- Free Wireless Internet
- A Clubhouse with a licensed cash bar (accepts debit card service), TVs and DVD player and features a balcony overlooking the marinas, parks and the picturesque western portion of Hamilton Harbour.

Adjacent to the club is a paved bike/skate/jog/walk waterfront trail leading to HMCS Haida and to Cootes Paradise, with an area of over 800 Hectares of ecologically

controlled wetlands and scenic conservation area beyond the western limit of the harbour. Within a half mile of MBYC is a municipal marina providing pump outs and fuel.

Life Jackets should be worn at all times by small children when they are on the MBYC docks.
