



## MACASSA BAY YACHT CLUB HOUSE RULES POLICY

### Purpose

These House Rules policies are a written order of direction and shall be implemented at all times consistently with the Club's By-laws to guide the Board of Directors.

1. A Member must be prepared to show proof of current membership in the Club at any time.
2. All Members shall 'sign-in', including all guests, when entering the Club.
3. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is restricted to the Club rooms and patio area, which are licensed. Only alcoholic beverages purchased at the Bar may be consumed in these areas.
4. Members, in good standing, are responsible for the conduct of their guest(s) while on Club property. Guests(s) must leave with the member with the exception of their immediate family.
5. Bar Hours are set up by the Board of Directors in response to current circumstances.
6. The Club premises must be vacated ½ hour after closing.
7. Animals are not permitted in the Club rooms or patio area at any time, **service animals** **excepted.**
8. The parking lots and boat slips are for members' convenience and enjoyment. Consideration for others is expected when using these facilities.
9. Obscene, abusive language, unruly behaviour and excessive noise will not be tolerated within the area of the Club property.
10. Only Regular and Social Members in good standing, and accompanying guests, are entitled to use the facilities of the Club rooms with the exception of their immediate family.
11. **No member or guest shall direct or reprimand an employee of the Club.** Complaints and/or suggestions should be directed, in writing, to the Club Secretary.
12. Alcoholic beverages purchased from Macassa Bay Yacht Club's bar may not be consumed outside the Club's licensed area.
