MBYC Facilities

CLUB BAR - Open most days but subject to change, due to season. Usually opens at 12 noon on weekends.

SATURDAY BBQ - Most Saturday during boat season, the club has a sausage/burger/hotdog BBQ Lunch. The BBQ is served in the gazebo at a nominal cost (debit/cash). This is a licensed area and all drinks must be purchased at the Club Bar.

SHOWERS - They are 2 shower rooms on the north side of the clubhouse. You need your FOB to enter.

PUMP OUT STATION - Visiting boaters with reciprocal privileges may use the MBYC's Pump Out Station for a nominal fee (\$). You will have to ask a member for assistance.

GARBAGE DISPOSAL - There is a large skip in centre of the parking lot. No recycling, please take home with you.

WI-FI - There is free Wi-Fi available at the docks and in the Club House. When checking in, you can obtain the codes for the Wi-Fi on the docks and Club House.

SAFETY - All visiting children should wear life jackets while near the water and on the docks.

BARBECUES - You can use your boat BBQs at MBYC or the BBQs at the end of each dock. Boaters tent on waterfront is available for private social activities and picnics. Tent in the garden is licensed and liquor must be purchased in the club bar.

Local Services

REFUELLING - Public gas dock (and serviced Pump Out) is located at Harbour West Marina which is a Municipal Operated Marina and is just down the shoreline from Macassa Bay Yacht Club.

COIN LAUNDRY - A laundromat is located a short walk from the club on James Street North at the corner of Burlington Street.

RESTAURANTS - There are many restaurants in the area. Walk up the hill to the right of the club and go straight along Strachan St., take a left at James Street, and walk to Pier 4 - Fisher's Restaurant and William's Coffee Pub - on the waterfront. Walk towards the downtown core by turning right on James Street. This entire street has been revitalized with interesting restaurants and art galleries. Take Bay Street at top of hill, turn right towards downtown and then left or right on Cannon Street, there are a few Chinese/ Vietnamese Restaurants. Crystal Dynasty Chinese Restaurant is one of them and popular with the asia community. Tim Horton's is also located here.

FAST FOOD - Our Bar does have snacks and sandwiches, but if your fancy a walk the plaza at James Street North, at the corner of Burlington Street has Grandad's Donuts, Weston Pizza & Wings take out (905-521-9919) and a well stocked variety store. Up the hill to the right of the Club, to Bay St. go right and Tim Horton's is located at the corner of Bay and Cannon St. At the top of the hill is Hutch's Fish & Chips a longtime favourite spot for Hamiltonians. They serve Ice Cream as well. There are also regular food trucks in the parking lot at the Bayfront Park next door.

BOAT SUPPLIES - We have two Marine supply stores. Dowsar is located on James St. North near the waterfront and Brewer Bros. on Ferguson St. and Barton. Both walking distance and well stocked!

GROCERIES - Food Basics & The Beer Store is located at Barton West and Mary Street. You can walk up the hill to the right of the club and go straight along Strachan St. turn right on Mary Street. Go over the rail bridge and the stores are on the left on Barton St. Nation's Supermarket is located at Bay St. and King St. Street. It specializes in Asian & International foods. Go up the hill and go right on Bay St., about a 20 minute walk. LCBO is located at the corner of James Street and King in Hamilton's City Centre Mall. Hamilton Farmers' Market is open usually Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday 8am - 6pm. Check before going. Hamilton City Centre Mall is located at James St. and King St. They sell almost everything. If you just need milk/bread, there are small variety stores on James Street North (*go left towards the water*) not far from MBYC.

THINGS TO DO* - TOURS: A tour boat leaves from Discovery Drive. The Hamiltonian (\$), a 12 person boat that does a 60 minute tour of the bay. The Waterfront Trolley travels along the entire trail from Discovery Drive to Coote's Paradise Nature Area and back (1.5 hrs) (\$). HMCS Haida - Tour a ship from World War II (\$), located at HMCS Star, off Guise St. Art Gallery of Hamilton, world class exhibits, admission fee. Browse the James St. N. - Art Galleries. Hamilton Place, top entertainers and shows. Newly refurbished Coliseum, usually lots of big name shows and events year round. All within walking distance, bus, or taxi.

BANK - There are many bank services in our downtown. Walk south down Bay Street or James Street.

GATES/SECURITY - The Club Gates are operated by a FOB. You will be given a FOB on arrival please drop it in the black locked box near the gate to Dock A or at the Bar (when open). To exit Club please use the "man" gate and do not try to slip through vehicle gate, it is not safe.
